

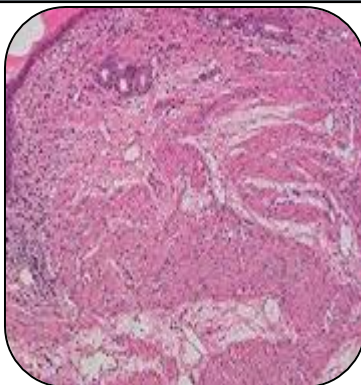

i) Received 6x5cm long gall bladder already cut open with stone.

Microscopy

i) Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus and lymphocytes with fibrocollagenous tissue.
