

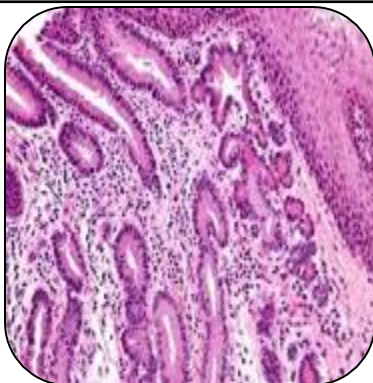

i) Received 2 tiny tissue pieces greyish white 0.5x1cm.

#### Microscopy

i) Section examined shows small endometrium glands having epithelial cells with small round nucleus with few broken endocervical cells and mononuclear endometrial Stroma.
