Left Breast Lump.

#### GROSS

i) Received 5x4cm tissue piece greyish white cystic with necrotic material.

#### Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows large number of lipid laden macrophages , Blood vessels , Fibrocollagenous tissue with mononuclear inflammatory cells and degenerated ductal cells.
- 2) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
