

GROSS

- i) Received 4x1cm fallopian tube.
- ii) Section shows tiny clot.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows tubal lining epithelium with large number of RBC in the lumen(Blood clot).
- 2) No trophoblastic cells or villi seen.
