

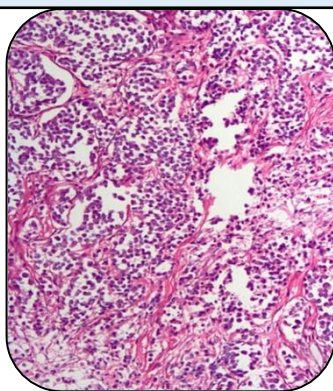

Features suggestive of metastatic carcinoma, L1 And L2 Vertebrae.

DIAGNOSIS

FALLOPIAN TUBE CONFIRMED AND UNREMARKABLE.

L1 And L2 Vertebrae.

GROSS

i) Received 2x3cm greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows cells arranged in small groups and in loosely cohesive sheets with large irregular vesicular nucleus and Anisonucleosis.
- 2) Section also shows granular necrosis binucleate and multinucleated giant cells with occasional bizarre large atypical cell.

ADVICE: KINDLY INVESTIGATE FOR PRIMARY.
