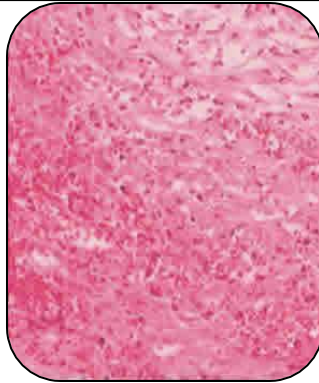
## SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT

### DIAGNOSIS

? FIBROTIC LESION.

**ADVICE : - Deeper biopsy is must for confirmative diagnosis(As tissue is very small)**



### SPECIMEN

Neck Swelling.

### GROSS

- i) Received multiple very tiny greyish white tissue pieces.

### Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows a bit of squamous lining epithelium having round to oval nucleus with fibrocollagenous tissue and small blood vessels.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
