

i) Received multiple greyish white tissue pieces.

## Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows Squamous lining epithelium with hyperkeratosis and parakerotosis.
- 2) Cells are small having round nucleus.
- 3) Deeper tissue shows fibrocollagenous tissue, blood vessels, glands.
- 4) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
