

1) Received 1x1cm and 0.5x0.5cm greyish white tissue pieces.

Microscopy

- i) Section examined shows Squamous lining epithelium having small round nucleus.
- ii) Deeper tissue shows fibrocollagenous tissue, blood vessels, endocervical glands and inflammatory cells.
- iii) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen in specimen received.
- iv) Section also shows koilocytes.
