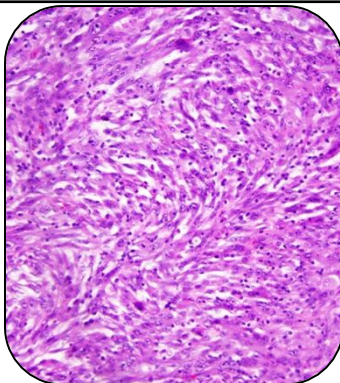


GROSS

- 1) Received 11x8cm uterus with ? cervix with bilateral tubes and ovaries.
- 2) Ovaries size 3x4cm and 4x5cm. Cut section shows large 3X4 cm fibroid.
- 3) One ovary shows haemorrhagic cyst.

Microscopy

- I) **Endometrium:** Atrophic
- II) **Myometrium:** Muscle Bundles
- III) **Fibroid:** Leiomyoma
- IV) **Ovary:** ovary shows leutal cyst and tube unremarkable.

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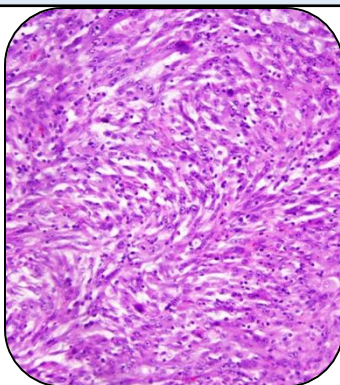
