

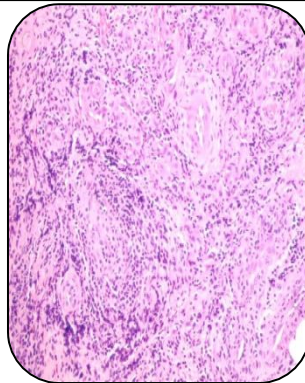

#### GROSS

1) Received two tiny tissue pieces greyish white.

#### Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows broken mucosal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus and mononuclear inflammatory cells and submucosal glands.
- 2) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
