

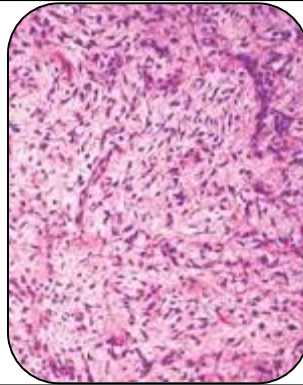

#### GROSS

- 1) Received Autolyzed tissue 1x2cm and 1x1cm two tissue pieces.

#### Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows fibrocollagenous tissue with multinucleated giant cells and mononuclear inflammatory cells.
- 2) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen
