

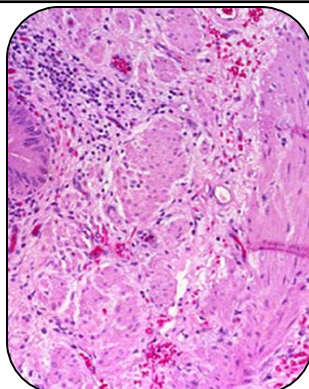

GROSS :

- 1) Received 6x2.5cm long gall bladder with no stones.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and Rokitansky Aschoff sinus (columnar lining epithelium round to oval nucleus) with lymphocyte within fibrocollagenous tissue.
