

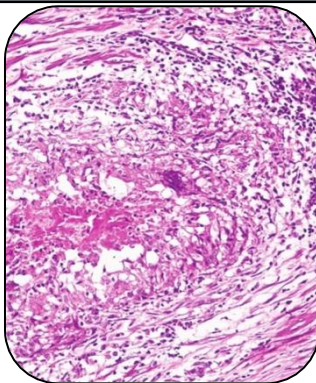

GROSS

- 1) Received multiple greyish white tissue pieces.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows mucosal lining epithelium and submucosal glands inflammatory cells(polymorphs, Lymphocytes, plasma cells and few histiocytes) with necrosis.
- 2) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
