

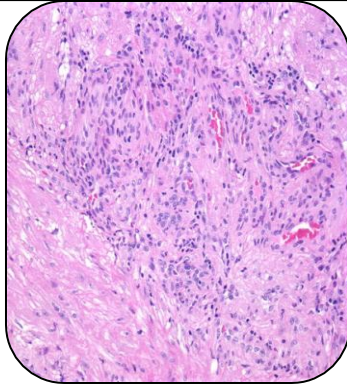

## SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT

### Non specific inflammation , Right Buccal Mucosa (Cheek)

#### DIAGNOSIS

**NON SPECIFIC INFLAMMATION.**



#### SPECIMEN

Right Buccal Mucosa (Cheek)

#### GROSS

1) Received 0.5x0.5cm greyish white tissue piece.

#### Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium having round to oval nucleus with parakeratosis.
- 2) Deeper tissue shows melanocytes , inflammatory cells, fibrocollagenous tissue and blood vessels.
- 3) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
