

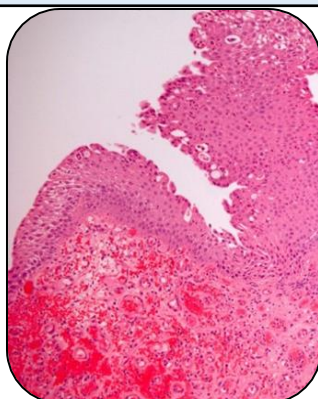

GROSS :

- 1) Received very tiny tissue pieces greyish white.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows stromal cells with oval nucleus, blood vessels and inflammatory infiltrate (lymphocytes, plasma cells and polymorphs).
- 2) No malignant cells seen.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request, for any of the above, will be entertained after the due date.
