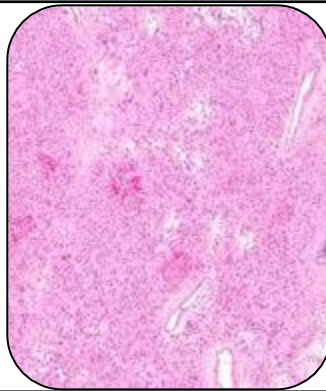

- 1) Received two tissue pieces 0.5x0.5cm greyish white.

#### Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows ovarian stromal cells, mature adipose cells, fibrocollagenous tissue, blood vessels squamous epithelial cells.
- 2) No granuloma and no malignant cells in sample received.
