

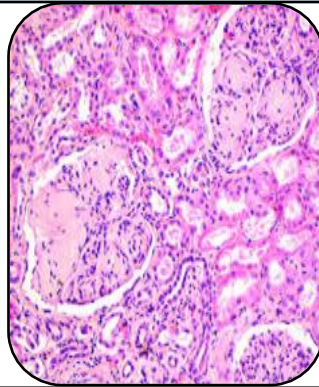

#### DIAGNOSIS

**TUBAL ECTOPIC PREGNANCY.**



#### SPECIMEN

Left fallopian tube

#### GROSS

- Received 5x1.5cm tubular tissue pieces. Cut section shows blood clot.

#### Microscopy

- Section examined shows lining epithelium with blood clot.
- No villi and no trophoblastic cells seen.
