

1) Received tiny greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows mucosal lining epithelium having cuboidal cells with small basal nucleus.
- 2) Submucosa shows glands and mononuclear inflammatory cells.
- 3) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
