

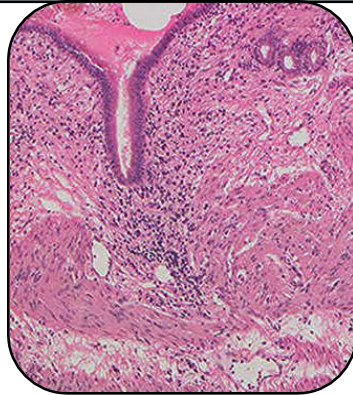

- 1) Received 7x3.5cm long gall bladder.
- 2) Already cut open with small stones.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus with lymphocyte within fibrocollagenous tissue.
