

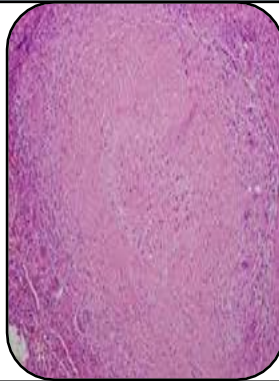

#### GROSS:

- 1) Received 3x2cm and 4x2.5cm greyish white tissue piece with skin.

#### Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows Squamous lining epithelium with mononuclear inflammatory cells and fibrocollagenous tissue.
- 2) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
