

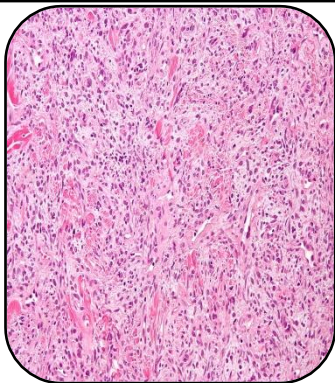

#### GROSS

1) Received two tissue pieces 1x1cm greyish white.

#### Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows fibrocollagenous tissue, salivary glands, muscle bundles, blood vessels.
- 2) No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
