

GROSS

1) Received 3x4cm greyish white tissue piece ulcerated area 3x2cm.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows Squamous lining epithelium having round to oval nucleus.
- 2) Deeper tissue shows heavy inflammatory infiltrate(lymphocytes).
- 3) No granuloma seen.
