

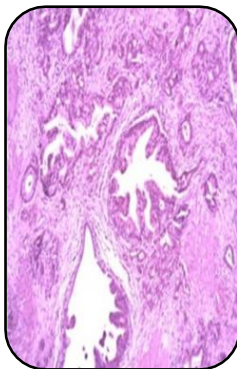

1) Received 6x3.8cm long gall bladder. Cut section shows stones.

Microscopy

1) Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus with lymphocyte within fibrocollagenous tissue.
