

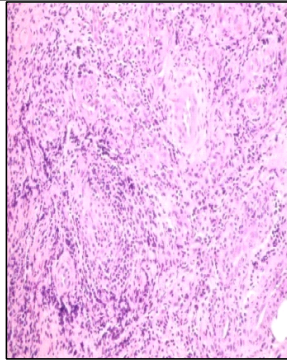

#### DIAGNOSIS

**CHRONIC INFECTIVE LESION ( TUBERCULAR PATHOLOGY SUSPICIOUS)**



#### SPECIMEN

Abscess gluteal.

#### GROSS

- Received multiple greyish white tissue piece size 3x2cm.

#### Microscopy

- Section examined shows fibrocollagenous tissue, blood vessel, mature adipose cell with lymphocytes, centrocytes, histiocytes with areas of necrosis.
- No malignant and no granuloma seen.
- AFB:- AFB not seen.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
