

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows fibrocollagenous tissue, blood vessel, mature adipose cell with lymphocytes, centrocytes, histiocytes with areas of necrosis.
- 2) No malignant and no granuloma seen.
- 3) AFB:- AFB not seen.
