

1) Received 1x1cm greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows Squamous lining epithelial having round to oval nucleus.
- 2) Deeper tissue show fibrocollagenous cell with large number of blood vessel and inflammatory cell with calcified areas.
- 3) No granuloma and no malignant cell seen.
