

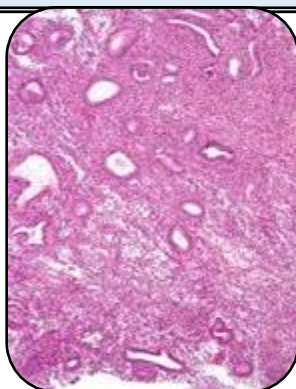

#### SPECIMEN:

Tubal ectopic.

#### GROSS:

- 1) Received 5x1.8cm long tubular tissue piece.
- 2) Cut section show blood clot.

#### Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows tubal lining epithelium with blood clot.
- 2) No trophoblastic cell and no villi seen.
