

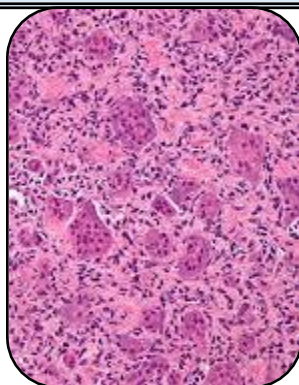

GROSS:

1) Received multiple greyish white tissue pieces.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows large number of cartilage having small round nucleus with fibrocollagenous tissue.
- 2) No granuloma seen.
