

# Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows fibrocollagenous tissue bony fragments, inflammatory cells (Lymphocyte, polymorph, histiocytes) with bits of cartilage.
- 2) Section also shows areas of granular necrosis and occasional atypical epithelial cells.
