

Left breast lump.

- 1) Received 4x5cm cystic tissue piece. Cut section shows clean fluid.
- 2) Received 4x5cm greyish white tissue piece. Cut section shows straw color fluid.

Microscopy

- 1) Section examined shows large number of dilated ducts with ductal cells having cuboidal lining epithelium with small round nucleus and fibrocollagenous tissue. No granuloma and no malignant cell seen.
- 2) Section examined shows large number of dilated ducts with ductal cells having cuboidal lining epithelium with small round nucleus and fibrocollagenous tissue. No granuloma and no malignant cell seen.
