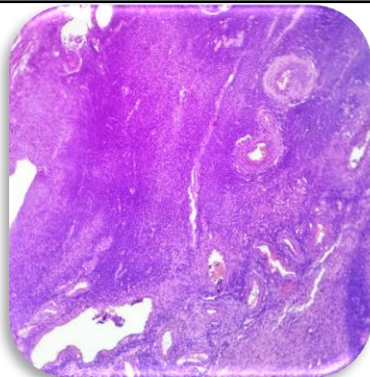

## **SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT** **RUPTURED ECTOPIC (LEFT SIDE TUBE AND OVARY).**

### **DIAGNOSIS**

**TUBAL ECTOPIC PRGNANCY.**



### **SPECIMEN**

Ruptured ectopic (left side tube and ovary)

### **GROSS**

- 1) Received 5.0 x 5.3 cm long tissue piece.
- 2) Cut section shows blood clot.

### **Microscopy**

- 1) Section examined shows tubal lining epithelium with large number of blood clot.
- 2) No villi and no trophoblastic cell seen.
- 3) Ovary shows simple cyst.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
