

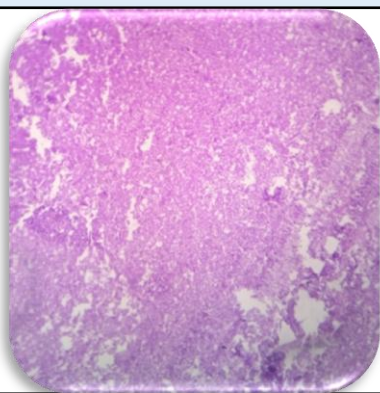

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows effacement of testicular architecture with fibrocollagenous tissue with inflammatory cells, polymorphs, pus cells.
2. No malignant cells seen.
3. No granuloma seen.
