

GROSS Received 5.6 x 6.0 cms greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows surface lining squamous epithelium with fibrocollagneous tissue.
- 2. Deeper part of the stroma shows presence of mature adipose cells separated with fibrous septa.
- 3. No granuloma seen.
- 4. No malignant cells seen.
