

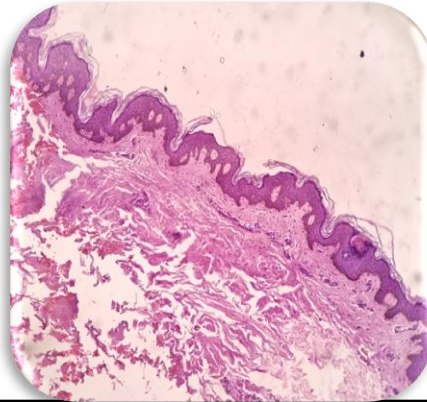

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows Squamous epithelial lining with marked hyperkeratosis and mild hyperparakeratosis with melanin pigmentation in the basal layer.
2. No granuloma seen.
3. No malignant cells seen.
