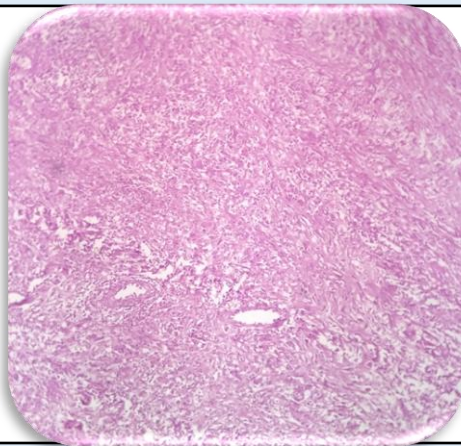

**GROSS**

Received 10.0 x 4.2 cm tissue piece with skin.  
Cut section shows tract.

**Microscopy**

1. Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium. Deeper tissue shows fibro collagenous tissue and heavy inflammatory infiltrate.
