

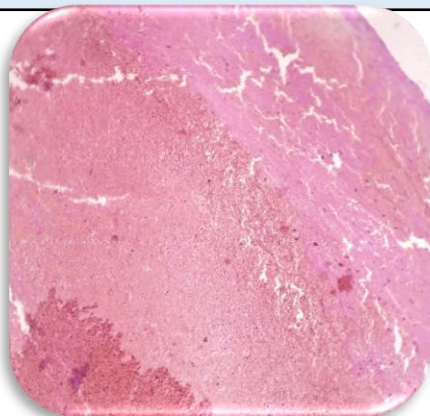

#### DIAGNOSIS

**TUBAL ECTOPIC PREGNANCY.**



#### **SPECIMEN**

Right Salphagectomy.

#### **GROSS**

Received 4.0 x 2.8 cm tubular tissue piece. Cut section shows blood clots.

#### **Microscopy**

1. Section examined shows tubal lining epithium with blood clot and trophoblastic cells.
2. No villi seen.
