

Received tiny tissue piece greyish white in color.

### Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows few submucosal glands with cuboidal lining epithelium, large number of mononuclear inflammatory cell.
- 2. Section also shows muscularis mucosa.
- 3. Section also shows parasitic cyst?
- 4. No granuloma seen.
