

Received multiple greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- Section examined shows multiple bits of tissue minor salivary gland acini with interlobular and intralobular ducts interspersed with inflammatory infiltrate chiefly composed of neutrophils, lymphocytes and plasma cells.
- 2. Presence of granulation tissue response.
