

GROSSING

Received 1x1cm greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus. Deeper tissue shows heavy inflammatory infiltrate with lymphocytes, polymorphs, plasmacytoid cells with histiocytes.
- 2. No granuloma seen.
- 3. No malignant cells seen.
