

DIAGNOSIS

MODERATELY DIFFERENTIATED SQUAMOUS CELL CARCINOMA.



SPECIMEN **Endometrial Ulcer** GROSSING Received two greyish white tissue pieces, 1x1 cm each.

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows squamous cells with atypical changes like anisonucleosis, altered N:C ratio, mitotic figures invading the stroma in form of islands and cords. Stroma shows inflammatory infiltrate.
