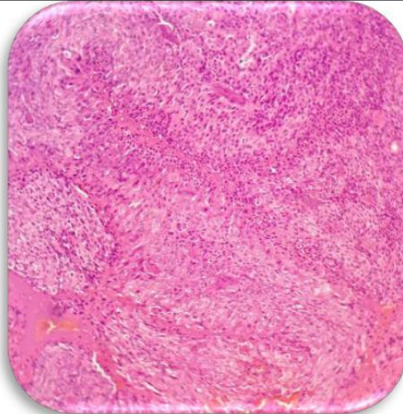
## SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT

### ENDOCERVICAL GROWTH

#### DIAGNOSIS

#### IMPRESSION

**MODERATELY DIFFERENTIATED SQUAMOUS CELL CARCINOMA.**



#### SPECIMEN

Endometrial Ulcer

#### GROSSING

Received two greyish white tissue pieces, 1x1 cm each.

#### Microscopy

- Section examined shows squamous cells with atypical changes like anisonucleosis, altered N:C ratio, mitotic figures invading the stroma in form of islands and cords. Stroma shows inflammatory infiltrate.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request, for any of the above, will be entertained after the due date.
