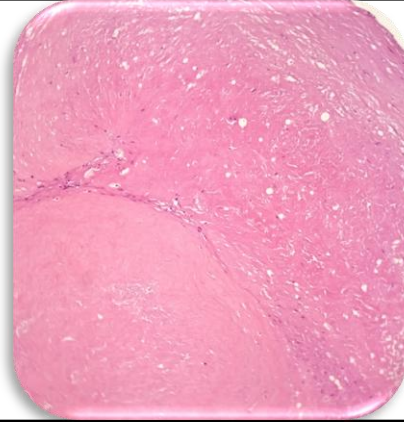
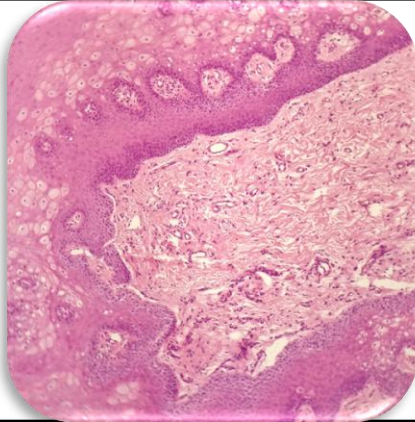

DIAGNOSIS

NON-CASEATING, NON-TUBERCULAR NECROTIZING LESION



SPECIMEN

Tongue Tissue.

GROSSING

Received two tiny creamish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows two bits of soft tissue.
2. One bit shows squamous lining epithelium with round and oval nucleus with inflamed connective tissue stroma.
3. Second bit of tissue shows non-caseating necrosis surrounded by few inflammatory cells.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request, for any of the above, will be entertained after the due date.
