

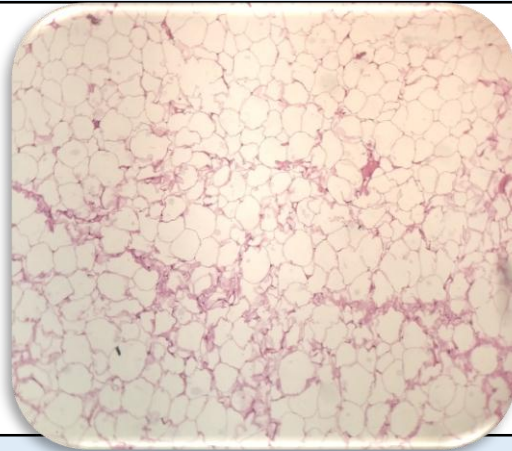

#### Microscopy
