

DIAGNOSIS

SIMPLE OVARIAN CYST WITH BLOOD CLOT

Advised: As, no trophoblastic cells seen. Kindly, rule out any ectopic pregnancy by clinical and radiological co-relation.



SPECIMEN

Right Tumor mass with Hemoperitonium and fallopian tube

GROSS

Received 5x2 cm ovary with tube with multiple greyish white tissue piece, 5x2 cm in aggregate.

Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows cyst lined by cuboidal lining epithelium and stromal cells. Tube is unremarkable.
- 2. Section also shows blood clot.
- 3. No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
- 4. No trophoblastic cells seen.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
