

Received 4x5cm with skin attached. Cut section shows necrotic material.

Microscopy

- Section examined shows Squamous lining epithelial with keratin flakes deeper tissue shows fibro collagenous tissue with large number of inflammatory cells (polymorph, lymphocyte).
- 2. No malignant and no granuloma seen.
