

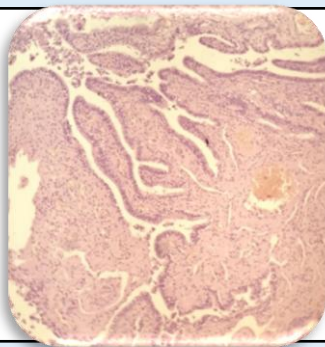

Received 5x4cm long cyst with fallopian tube cyst shows clear fluid

#### **Microscopy**

1. Section examined from the cyst shows lining epithelium having small round to oval nucleus with fibrocollagenous tissue.
2. No malignant and no granuloma seen.
3. Tube unremarkable
