

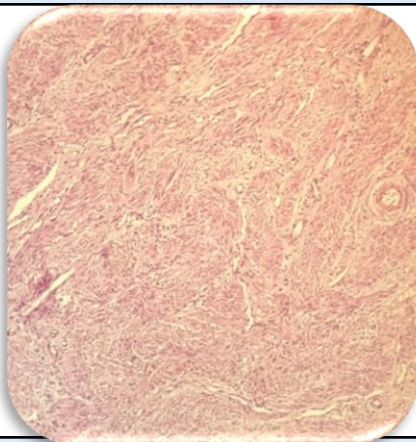

LEIOMYOMA WITH CERVICAL POLYP



SPECIMEN

Uterus

GROSS

Received 9x5cm uterus with cervix with 3x2.1cm and 3.1x2.2cm ovary. Cut section shows 2x2cm fibroid and 1x1cm cervical polyp .

Microscopy

Section examined shows

1. Endometrium with proliferative phase.
2. Myometrium with muscle bundles.
3. Fibroid with inter lacing muscles bundles.
4. Cervix with mononuclear inflammatory cells.
5. Polyp with endocervical glands.
6. Ovary with simple cyst and tube unremarkable.
7. Other ovary with hemorrhagic cyst and simple cyst and tube unremarkable.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
