

GROSSING

Received 6x3 cm greyish white tissue piece with skin.

Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows hyperorthokeratotic squamous lining epithelium with round to ovary nucleus overlying the connective tissue stroma.
- 2. Stroma shows fibrocollagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes and plasma cells)
