

Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows three bits of tissue with hyperplastic stratified squamous epithelium.
- One of the bit shows dysplastic changes like altered N:C ratio, Pleomorphism, dyskeratosis, hyperchormatism.
- 3. Stroma shows inflammatory cells chiefly composed of lymphocytes and plasma cells.
