

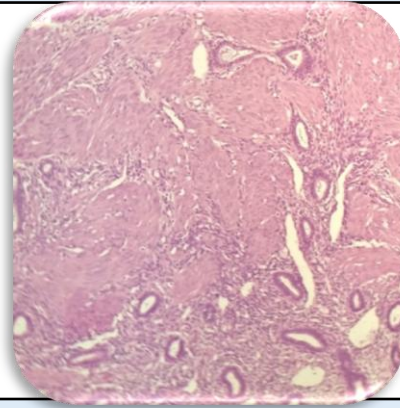
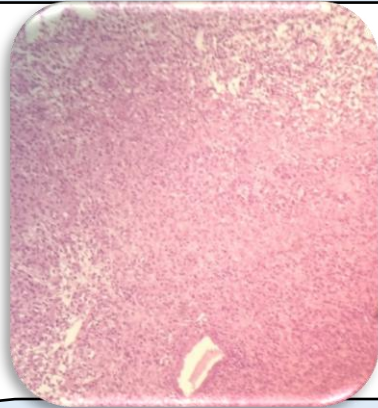

#### Microscopy

- (1) Section examined shows endocervical cells with stromal cells having round to oval nucleus.
- (2) Section examined shows scanty endometrial tissue with RBCs with inflammatory cells and few stromal cells. No endometrial gland seen in sample received
